Animals under 7 years of age

I understand that it is of high quality medicine to perform bloodwork on any animal undergoing anesthesia. I also understand that it is not required but recommended for animals under 7 years of age. I hereby allow the Cazenovia Animal Hospital to perform a pre-surgical panel on my pet. (\$52.50). Although this is not a guarantee, I understand that it will help in seeing some unforeseen problems that could arise. Choosing to perform pre-anesthetic bloodwork does not guarantee prevention of unforeseen complication.

Animals over 7 years of age

I understand that when an animal is over 7 years of age the body can have unforeseen diagnostic problems. I understand that bloodwork is required and I am responsible for the cost (\$52.50). If abnormalities are detected, the veterinarian may elect to place an I.V. catheter or cancel the anesthetic procedure. I do hereby allow the hospital to perform whatever necessary to better the chances of the anesthetic procedure being performed. _____ Initials

Intravenous Catheter

When an animal is placed under anesthesia problems can occur. An intravenous catheter may be placed to help in case a problem was to arise while under anesthesia. It will help to keep blood pressure at a more controlled level as well as keep access to a vein available if medications or lifesaving drugs need to be administered. I understand that while an I.V. catheter is not routine, a catheter may be placed if it is in the best judgment of the attending veterinarian. _____ Initials

Dentistry

If dentistry has been requested, it will include scaling and polishing. Extractions are additional and cost depends on the number and difficulty of removal. An antibiotic may be dispensed.
